In the sixth of them by Claudia Rosa Acevedo, Lucas Andrade de Freitas and Bruno Catão in the study of the Effect of the reputation of digital influencers on ewom, perceived risk and purchase intention of instagram users, seeks evidence to understand how the influence of the reputation of influencers of Instagram in the purchase decision of users.
